

Concepts in Collage

Understanding Substrates, Composition and Subject Matter – Alicia Leeke, Instructor

In this fast-paced class, you will learn how to create one-of-a-kind, original, collage works of art on simple and complex substrates. After a demo by the instructor, students will learn how to take ideas and put them into action using paper, paint and other materials to create decorative and functional works of art. Emphasis will be placed on creativity, color and composition. The only prerequisite is a willingness to have fun and learn in this playful class.

Supply List

Substrate:

Vision Mixed Media Pad (9 x 12 or larger)

2 – 8 x 10 primed boards (if you work fast, you can purchase more during class at City Art)

Glass substrate provided by instructor

Acrylic Paints Basic Sets:

Amsterdam (or your preference of Windsor & Newton, Holbein or Golden brand) including these colors: Red, Blue, Yellow, Green, Black, White

Make sure your set includes a Mars Black and Titanium white or equivalent

Any other favorite paint colors you prefer.

Palette

Your choice or Styrofoam Plates

Brushes:

1 large brush to prime surfaces Lou Cornell 3 Brush Set (#1140)

1-4 Foam brushes

Inexpensive Variety Pack of Synthetic or Bristle Brushes that includes flat and round brushes

1 Permanent Black Sharpie Marker to draw with and to sign your name

Liner brush to sign your name (0 or 1 short liner)

Palette Knife for mixing and painting (optional)

Any kind of extra brushes or paint pens (optional)

Supplies:

Gesso 16 oz. (priming)

Golden Gloss Acrylic Medium 4 oz (gluing)

Artists Tape ½ inch

X-acto Knife and scissors

Brayer (rubber) 3 or 4 inch

Soft sponge

Pencil and eraser for drawing

Permanent Sharpie Marker Fine Point for drawing and signing your name

Ruler 12 inch or larger

Small container with lid for water

Paper Towels

3-4 Magazines with a lot of good floral and art images (Art & Antique Magazine is great)

Tissue paper (bring scraps from presents if you have it)

Sandpaper (provided by instructor)

Apron, smock or protective clothing if you're a messy painter like me.
