Supports

2 small canvases (or boards)

Paint

Professional quality paint in the colors below make a good standard palette. M. Graham, Holbein, and Winsor Newton are the brands of regular oils I use the most. Also, Holbein makes a water-soluble line of paint which I use frequently.

Titanium White (or Titanium/Zinc Mixture)

Cad Yellow Light (or a similar yellow)
Indian Yellow

Cad Red Light or Scarlet (or a similar color)
Alizarin Crimson Permanent

Ultramarine Blue
Phthalo Blue

Yellow Ocher
Burnt Sienna
Raw Umber
Ivory Black or Mars Black

Extended Palette

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Raw Sienna
Cerulean Blue
Diox. Purple
Transparent Red Oxide
Viridian
Phalo Green
Quinacridone Rose, Perm. Rose, or Magenta

Mediums

M Graham Alkyd Medium or Linseed Oil

If you are using Regular Oils, Gamsol OMS (or equivalent OMS product) a closed container is needed (No Turps!)

Brushes:

Various size oil brushes of your choice. 3 or 4 high quality flats or filberts and a small round for signing your name, etc.

1 or 2 Palette Knife(s)

Other Items:

Viva Paper Towels

Pencil

Kneaded Eraser

Small plastic container (cap from a prescription bottle or Coke)

Disposable Mixing Tablet (or Mixing Palette of your choice)
