Primed Canvas - Instructor uses $8^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}, 9^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$. You may use smaller or larger. Instructor will also demonstrate painting on other surfaces that are optional, and you may want to purchase at a later date after seeing demos. (Suggestions: Wood Panels, Gessobord, Watercolor pads)

Acrylic Paints: heavy body or fluid acrylic paints (Instructor uses Golden Fluid Acrylic Paints in set of 10, but other brands may be used. And, other similar colors may be used. Bring what you have if you've painted before.) Favorite Additives are "Gloss Glazing Liquid" and "Retarder"
